DIE 3-BENIGE POT

THE REAL SHEPHERD'S PIE

Ingredients

2 tablespoons oil
1 small onion, chopped
1 large potato, chopped
3 tablespoons flour
salt and pepper to taste
1 cup frozen peas
1 can beef broth
1 kg lamb / beef steak, cubed
2 sheets ready rolled pastry
1 egg yolk mixed with 2 tbs milk for glazing

Directions

Pour oil in a saucepan and add onions and potato. Cook for about 5 minutes, stirring constantly. Add flour and a little salt and pepper. Then add the peas and stir. Pour in the beef broth and stir until it is nice and thick and bubbly. Add the chopped beef or lamb (make sure you chop it into small bite-sized cubes) and stir. Grease a deep 23cm pie plate and line the bottom with one ready rolled pastry. Make sure there's a little bit of pastry overlapping. Pour the filling into the pie plate. Brush the edges of the pastry with the milk and egg yolk glaze. Gently place the other ready rolled pastry on top. Press the edges of the pastries together to seal. Trim off any extra pastry and press around the pie with a fork. Cut 4 steam holes on the top and brush the top of the pastry with the rest of the glaze. Bake in a 220 °C degree oven for 30 minutes. Serves 4. Delicious!

BROWN SUGAR BARBEQUE

CHICKEN WINGS

Ingredients

Serves 8
2 cups tomato sauce
1 cup light brown sugar
2 tbs Worcestershire sauce
2 tbs cider vinegar
Salt and ground pepper
2.5 kg chicken drumettes, patted dry

Directions

In a medium bowl, whisk together ketchup, sugar, Worcestershire and vinegar; season with salt and pepper. Set aside 1 cup sauce for tossing raw chicken; use rest for baked chicken.

Preheat oven to 230 °C, with racks in upper and lower thirds; line two rimmed baking sheets with foil.

Divide drumettes between baking sheets, and toss with reserved 1 cup sauce.

Bake chicken until opaque throughout, 30 to 35 minutes, rotating sheets and tossing chicken halfway through. Toss baked drumettes with 1/2 cup sauce, and serve with remaining sauce on the side.

Helpful Hint

Chicken drumettes are actually the back part of the chicken wing - just the right size for kids to nibble on. To store, refrigerate up to 2 weeks

KID'S FAV MEATLOAF

Ingredients

Serves 8

120ml Tomato Sauce
25g Brown Sugar
5ml Prepared mustard
15ml Worcestershire sauce
Salt & Pepper
Onion & Garlic powder
1 Egg
15ml Milk
75g Crispy wheat cereal squares
680g Minced beef / lamb / pork

Directions

In a large mixing bowl, combine tomato sauce, brown sugar & mustard, mix well. Remove 4 tbs of this mixture for later use, to top loaves. To mixture in bowl, add Worcestershire sauce, salt, pepper, garlic powder, onion powder, egg & milk, mix well.

Stir in the wheat cereal squares and let stand for 5 minutes. Break up cereal squares & add minced meat, mix well. Shape this mixture into mini loaf pans or large loaf pans.

Bake at 175 °C for 65 minutes. Brush on reserved sauce mix & bake for 15 minutes more. Serve with rice / couscous / salad.

of me. I am the color of silence.

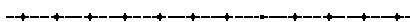
You hardly notice me, but without me you all become superficial. I represent thought and reflection, twilight and deep water. You need me for balance and contrast, for prayer and inner peace."

Deel 2

Vrae en antwoorde oor onderwerpe van belang vir lede van die Kerk. Hierdie deel is basies bedoel vir studie deur ouer kinders; dit kan egter ook gebruik word vir die onderrig van jong lede van die Kerk. Dit behoort nie van kinders verwag te word om vrae en antwoorde te memoriseer nie, maar die vrae moet planmatig vir hulle opgeklaar word sodat hulle in die evangelie opgewasse en bekwaam gemaak kan word.

2. Hierdie geskrif poog nie om 'n uiteensetting te gee van die leerstelling van die Kerk nie en is nie 'n middel waardeur bekering bewerkstellig, of saligheid bekom kan word nie. 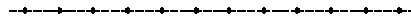

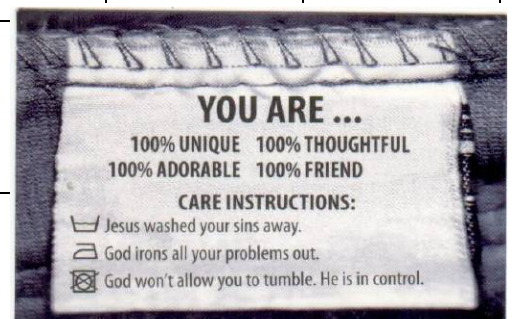
